There are certain things we need to be certain about when it comes to being followers of Jesus and John clarifies five of the issues we all face.

- I. The end will come (18a)
 - A. The "last hour" commenced with the incarnation of Christ
 - 1. That is why Satan tried to have him killed by King Herod
 - 2. That is why Satan tempted Him to sin and thus fail
 - 3. That is why Satan worked to have him crucified
 - B. The "last hour" was confirmed at the resurrection of Christ
 - 1. When Jesus rose, Satan lost
 - 2. When Satan lost, he got mad
 - 3. When Satan gets mad, Christians suffer
 - C. The "last hour" was clarified at the ascension of Christ (Acts 1:9-11)
 - D. The "last hour" will conclude with the return of Christ
- II. The enemy will fight (18b)
 - A. Antichrist(s) can mean "against" Christ
 - B. Antichrist(s) can mean "in place" of Christ (2 Thessalonians 2:1-4)
- III. The imposters will leave (19)
 - A. This happened in Jesus's day after he fed the 5,000 (John 6:60-69)
 - B. This happened in Jesus's day after the triumphal entry (John 12:2-19)
 - C. This is happening in our day and seems to be increasing
- IV. The truth will win (20-24)
- V. The promise will happen (25-27)

Just to be Clear!

- As followers of Jesus we do not need to fear the end of the world since it is part of God's plan. (2 Peter 3:10-13)
- As followers of Jesus we know that Satan is working against anything and everything about us.
 (1 Peter 5:8-9)
- As followers of Jesus we must understand that there will be those who just don't understand. (1 Peter 2:4-10)
- As followers of Jesus we should stand firm because in the end God's Word will be proven true. (1 Peter 4:12-17)
