He is also a man who suffered much at the hands of those who refuse to believe in Jesus. Despite the opposition from, Jewish religious leaders, Roman politicians and Greek philosophers, John had never backed down because he knew he was right. No one would ever change his mind! He would die before denying his Lord and Savior Jesus Christ.

And he who has seen has testified, and his testimony is true; and he knows that he is telling the truth, so that you may believe. (John 19:35)
