 - A. The rapture closes the church age
 - B. The resurrection completes the church body
- II. Israel is waiting to meet their Messiah in Jerusalem.
 - A. The Kingdom was initiated in Israel's exodus (Exodus 15:1-3, 12-18)
 - B. The Kingdom was interrupted in Israel's past
 - 1. When they demanded a human king (1 Samuel 8:4-9)
 - 2. When they rejected their divine King (John 19:12-16)
 - C. The Kingdom was implied in Israel's songs (Psalm 24)
 - D. The Kingdom was included in the Lord's Prayer (Matthew 6:9-13)
