The world desperately needs to see the gospel really works

- I. People need to see the gospel works in us (Philippians 1:27-28)
 - A. It changes our home
 - B. It changes our heart
 - C. It changes our head
- II. People need to see the gospel works through us
 - A. We must accept the distinctions
 - 1. righteousness not lawlessness (principles not people)
 - 2. light not darkness (some things just don't mix)
 - 3. Christ not Satan (some notes never harmonize)
 - 4. believer not unbeliever
 - 5. temple of God not idols
 - 6. Spirit not the flesh (Galatians 5:16-24)
 - B. We must appreciate the distinctions
 - 1. God's instructions are for our benefit
 - 2. God's limitations are for our benefit
 - 3. God's intentions are for our benefit
 - C. We must act on the distinctions
 - 1. Intellectually think Spiritually (Philippians 4:8)
 - 2. Emotionally feel honestly
 - 3. Volitionally choose wisely (Philippians 4:9)
