John closes his resurrection account with an extended narrative and then 2 final pieces of information.

    - 1. God's plan for Peter did not include returning to commercial fishing
    - 2. God's plan for Peter may or may not be instruction for you and me (John Phillips story)
  - B. 1 on the shore (4-5)
  - C. 153 in the net (6-11)
    - 1. The number of languages in the world at that time
    - 2. The number of races and tribes in the world at that time
    - 3. The number of different kinds of fish in the Sea of Galilee
    - 4. The symbolic meaning of adding ten and seven
    - 5. Cyril stated that 100 stood for Gentiles and 50 stood for Jews and 3 for the Trinity
    - 6. Augustine asserted that this number refers to the Ten Commandments and the seven gifts of the Spirit, which equals the number seventy.
    - 7. If you add up each number 1, 2, 3, 4 through 17 you get 153...the total number who came to Christ through the law and grace
  - D. at the fire (12-14)
  - E. 2 on the beach (15-17)
    - 1. Did Peter think he really loved Jesus more than the other disciples?
    - 2. Did Peter think he was more committed than the other disciples?
    - 3. Did Peter think he was more courageous than the other disciples?
    - 4. Did Peter think his ministry was over because Jesus was leaving?
      - a. There were lambs to feed
      - b. There were sheep to tend
      - c. There were sheep to feed
- II. The information
  - A. The author saw everything he wrote
  - B. What he wrote is not all that he saw

## So What?

"Worship is our active, all of life response to the worth of who God is and what he does."

- I worship best remembering Jesus is always with me.
- I worship best remembering how often I fail Him. (3)
- I worship best remembering I'm not better than you. (15)
- I worship best remembering who Jesus really is. (12)
- I worship best comparing myself to Him not to you. (21)
- I worship best serving Him through serving others. (15,16,17)
